Village at Brickett Hill pet policy

M. PETS

Residents are permitted to have no more than two (2) pets (cats or dogs only) provided that the following regulations are met. All pet regulations, and registration requirements, also apply to any pets that are being fostered.

- a. Pets must be registered with the Board of Trustees. All Unit Owners are required to complete and submit a Pet Registration form and are responsible for a one-time fee of \$10 per pet.
- b. Residents who fail to properly register their pet will receive one written warning with a 1-week grace period to complete that registration. Residents who fail to complete a pet registration beyond that 1-week grace period will be subjected to a \$25 fine. Additional fines in the amount of \$25 will be issued on a weekly basis until pet registration is complete.
- c. The consent so given may be revoked at any time.
- d. The City of Haverhill and The Village at Brickett Hill have a leash law for dogs. All dogs must be leashed at all times. The city also requires that dog licenses be renewed annually. For more information visit: www.cityofhaverhill.com.
- e. No pets, including cats, shall be left outside unattended, nor shall they be chained to a post or run of any sort on the common area.
- f. While walking your cat or dog a "pooper scooper" or plastic bag must be used to remove the waste regardless of weather conditions. Such waste must be properly disposed of in the unit owner's/resident's trash receptacle.
- g. Unless permission was specifically granted otherwise prior to the issue of this handbook, pets shall be limited to two (2) per unit and must have a <u>combined</u> total weight of no more than fifty (50) pounds at pet(s) maturity.
- h. Upon the death of a pet, replacement will not be allowed without the prior permission of the Board of Trustees.
- i. No reptiles are permitted at any time.
- j. Dog owners must assume liability if a pet should cause harm to any person or damage to any VBH property and therefore are advised to check with your homeowners' insurance carrier for appropriate coverage. Some insurance carriers do not extend coverage to particular breeds of dog.
- k. The following dog breeds, or any mixture of the below breeds are **prohibited** on the Premises. This includes miniature versions of these breeds and/or mix of breeds:
